Regions may set lower roster limits for their Region to ensure better playing time

9. Playing Rules

No deliberate heading in 12U and below - teach chest control, not high kicks

12U - 9v9 Punting IS allowed

10U - 7v7 Build out Line, No Punting

8U - 6v6 including Goalkeeper, Build Out Line, No Punting

Modified 3/4 play in 8U through 14U, 1619U is half play with monitoring sheet

10. COVID protocols - hopefully none, but subject to change

11. Standings

Standings will be kept in 10U and above

No score to be kept in 8U - game cards are to keep track of subs only

12. Referee Plan and Game Control

U8 - Team Referees

Should be certified if at all possible, but may play without a certified person

10U standings points system - must referee 10 games

Basic Referee Companion Course - Orville Wright Middle School Sat. 3/5 2:00PM

Must do online portion FIRST and BRING CONFIRMATION OF COMPLETION!!!

12U and up - no points system, but encourage experienced referee parents to contribute

All teams should be prepared to provide a Club Linesperson for their side of the field

13. Sportsmanship

Players play better when the coaches and parents are respectful and totally under control

Coaches are responsible for their players and sideline

Avoid use of "rose colored glasses" - beware of the bad angle

Strategies to temper blowouts

Teaching and monitoring to avoid taunting of any kind, including racial, ethnic, religious, etc.
