- **ROSTERS – Ian McCullen**
  - Only "Activated" SportsConnect Tournament team rosters, with uniform numbers in numerical order, will be accepted. **Coaches – please make sure your uniform numbers are promptly provided to your RC/Admin**
  - Regional Commissioners or designee must submit League Rosters by Sunday, December 17, 2023. All Star Rosters are due by January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023
  - Coaches must always have medical release forms at practices and games for all rostered players
  - Roster limits for All-Stars by Division - 10U All-Stars is 7v7 with roster limit of 9, 12U All-stars is 9v9 with roster limit of 12, 14U All-Stars is 11v11 with roster limit of 14
- **COACH & ASSISTANT COACH REQUIREMENTS - Mike Riley**
  - Age-Appropriate Training
    - **ALL** coaches and assistant coaches **MUST** be Age Appropriate Certified
    - 10U, 12U, Intermediate (14U)
    - **Courses offered in Arcadia Saturday January 6th**
  - Volunteer Registration
    - Entered into SportsConnect for MY2022
  - "AYSO's Safe Haven" Certification
  - CDC Concussion Training
  - Sudden Cardiac Arrest Training
  - Current (not expired!) Sterling Volunteers Background Check
  - LiveScan (fingerprinting)
  - SafeSport
- **COACH AUTHORIZATION CARD**
  - Authorization Card – will be distributed at team check in – non-transferrable.

- No authorized coach present = no match!!! RC or qualified designee can be substitute coach
- **TEAM CHECK IN – Ian McCullen/Michael Sweeney/Ralph Bryne**
  - All League teams will check in at Campus El Segundo on Sunday, January 8<sup>th</sup> beginning at 7:45 am.
  - All Star teams will check in at Campus El Segundo on Saturday, January 28<sup>th</sup> (or Sunday January 29<sup>th</sup> if first game)
  - Each team must have all players in uniform and medical release forms for every player
  - Must have FIVE (5) game cards FILLED OUT (a few Allstar teams will need to fill out a 6<sup>th</sup> card at check-in)
  - Please have your team check in 60 minutes ahead of game time (75-90 mins. if you must travel to a different field)
- **LINEUP (Game) CARDS – Ian McCullen**
  - Complete **FRONT ONLY. Team Number (i.e. 7A) at top and Date/Time/Field at bottom** are critical information.
  - **Must include ALL players on the roster and be in NUMERICAL order**
  - Cards will be kept by referees at conclusion of the game
  - Sportsmanship point deduction for missing/incorrect information
- **REFEREES AND SPORTSMANSHIP – Chris Wong**
- **DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS**
  - Sent off players shall not participate further in the game in any way, including the hand shake line
  - Multi-game suspensions for Violent Conduct, Spitting/Biting, Serious Foul Play, and Offensive, Insulting, Abusive Language/Gestures
  - **Note: Section 1 Tournament Rule – team members sent off for violent conduct are NOT ELIGIBLE!**
  - Area Director may impose supplemental discipline
  - Low tolerance of spectator involvement – quick send-offs
  - No tolerance of any type of hate speech
- **RULES & REGULATIONS**
  - Published on web site - download and read!
  - If you don't read anything else!
  - All 10U play is 7v7 and 12U play is 9v9 – “Modified” ¾ play **in League only** if necessary due to roster size
  - Home Team Side of Field
    - Adams (North Redondo) - South
    - Washington (North Redondo) - East
    - Village (Manhattan Beach) - West
    - Anza (Hawthorne) - East
    - Alta Vista (South Redondo) - West
    - Perras (South Redondo) - West
    - Campus El Segundo - Middle of the Complex for 14U/North for 10U fields

  - League Schedule on website by Thursday 12/21; games will start Sunday, January 7<sup>th</sup>
  - All Star Schedule on website about January 10<sup>th</sup>; games will start Saturday, January 27<sup>th</sup>
  - League and Premier All-Star winners (and wild cards) advance to Section tournament
    - League February 24-25. All-Star March 2-3
- **FIELDS MAPS** (see web pages)
- **FACILITIES**
  - All of our fields are artificial turf
  - **Note: Only water is allowed on turf fields. No food or flavored/sugary drinks. No Exceptions!**
  - Must obey all local field rules as posted!
  - **No 4-legged chairs** are allowed on artificial turf fields (all our fields are artificial turf)
  - **Some Regions allow** low beach chairs (with bars) on turf at other fields if there is no close asphalt
  - Please remind your parents and players to clean up after yourselves. We are guests on these fields.
  - Setup and takedown are BOTH teams' responsibility – 1 goal each or loss of SP
  - No Dogs Allowed!
